BIS-SAHHA tas-setgħat mogħtija lilu skont l-artikoli 74(5) u 75(6) tal-Att dwar l-Edukazzjoni (Kap. 327), il-Kanċillier tal-Università ta' Malta ppromulga dawn l-ordinamenti magħmulin mill-Bord tal-Fakultà tal-Medicina u l-Kirurgija bis-saħħa tas-setgħat mogħtija lilu skont l-artikolu 81(1) ta' dak l-Att u li ġew approvati mis-Senat tal-Università ta' Malta kif jirrikjedi l-artikolu 81(2) ta' dak l-Att:

It-Titolu u l-Interpretazzjoni

1. (1) Dawn l-ordinamenti jistgħu jissejġu bħala l-Ordinamenti tal-2012 skont ir-Regolamenti Ġenerali tal-2008 għar-Rikonoxximenti Universitarji ta' wara l-Ewwel Grad għall-Grad ta' Master of Pharmacy – M.Pharm. - taht il-patroċinju tal-Fakultà tal-Medicina u l-Kirurgija.

(2) F'dawn l-ordinamenti, kemm-il darba r-rabta tal-kliem ma teħtiegħ mod ieħor –

“il-Bord” tfisser il-Bord tal-Fakultà tal-Medicina u l-Kirurgija;

“il-Grad” tfisser il-grad ta' Master of Pharmacy – M.Pharm.;

“il-Kors” tfisser il-programm ta' studju li jwassal għall-grad ta' Master of Pharmacy – M.Pharm.; u

“ir-Regolamenti Prinċipali” tfisser ir-Regolamenti Ġenerali tal-2008 għar-Rikonoxximenti Universitarji ta' wara l-Ewwel Grad.

L-Applikabilità

2. Dawn l-ordinamenti għandhom japplikaw għall-korsijiet li jibdwu f'Ottubru 2011 jew wara.

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Ir-Rekwiziti għad-Dhul

3. (1) Il-Kors huwa miftuħ għall-applikanti li għandhom il-grad ta' Bachelor of Science (Honours) (Pharmaceutical Science) miksub tal-anqas fit-Tieni Klassi bl-Unuri.

(2) L-applikanti li għandhom il-grad ta' Bachelor of Science (Honours) (Pharmaceutical Science) miksub fit-Tielet Klassi bl-Unuri jkunu eliġibbli li japplikaw jekk jissottomettu portafoll ta' tliet snin prattika f'qasam relatat mal-farmaċija.

It-Tul tal-Kors

4. Il-Kors għandu jinfirx fuq tliet semestri ta' studju fuq bazi *full-time*.

Il-Programm ta' Studju

5. (1) Il-programm ta' studju għandu jikkonsisti minn taqsimiet studju li għalihom hemm assenjati total ta' 90 krettu, li minnhom 60 krettu huma assenjati għal taqsimiet studju mghallma u 30 krettu assenjati għat-taqsimi studju tad-dissertazzjoni.

(2) Il-programm ta' studju għandu jkun ippubblikat wara l-approvazzjoni tas-Senat, normalment mhux anqas minn tmien xhur qabel il-bidu tal-Kors u għandu jinkludi:

(a) taħriġ teoretiku u prattiku fis-suġġetti li ġejjin:

Pharmacy Practice

Clinical Pharmacy

Community Health Care

Legislation and Professional Ethics;

(b) tal-anqas sitt xhur ta' taħriġ ġo spiżerija miftuħa għall-pubbliku jew fi sptar taħt is-supervizjoni tad-dipartiment tal-farmaċewtika ta' dak l-isptar; u

(c) taqsimi studju tad-dissertazzjoni.

Il-Valutazzjoni u l-Progress

6. Il-valutazzjoni tat-taqsimiet studju mghallma għandha ssir sal-aħħar tas-semestru li fih ikun sar it-tagħlim tat-taqsimiet studju.

Id-Dissertazzjoni

7. (1) L-istudenti huma meħtieġa jipprezentaw dissertazzjoni individwali ta' madwar 25,000 kelma. It-titlu tad-dissertazzjoni u l-proposta dettaljata tar-riċerka għandhom ikunu sottomessi fiż-żmien tas-sejha tal-applikazzjonijiet.

(2) Kull student ikun assenjat superviżur li għandu jipprovdi gwida u pariri fuq bażi regolari waqt il-perijodu ta' studju.

8. (1) L-istudenti għandhom iżommu kuntatt regolari mas-superviżur tagħhom.

(2) Is-superviżuri għandhom jibgħatu lill-Bord rapporti dwar il-progress ta' kull student taħt is-superviżjoni tagħhom fit-tmiem ta' kull semestru ta' studju. Dawn ir-rapporti jistgħu jinkludu rakkomandazzjoni li jew (a) jittawwal il-perijodu ta' studju biex l-istudent ikun jista' jtemm id-dissertazzjoni; jew (b) jintemmu l-istudji qabel il-waqt jekk is-superviżur jidhirlu li dan huwa xieraq fiċ-ċirkostanzi, sakemm li:

(i) l-estensjoni tal-perijodu ta' studju msemmija f'(a) tkun skont il-provvedimenti tar-Regolamenti Prinċipali; u

(ii) il-Bord ma jistax itemm l-istudji qabel il-waqt skont (b) jekk qabel ma jkunx ta opportunità lill-istudent biex jiddefendi l-każ tiegħu.

II-Klassifikazzjoni tar-Rikonoxximent

9. Il-Marka Medja Finali Mwieżna għall-iskop tal-klassifikazzjoni tal-Grad għandha tkun ibbażata fuq ir-rizultati miksuba fil-komponenti kollha tal-programm ta' studju, bil-kretti kollha jingħataw piż indaqs.

(CAP. 327)****Bye-Laws of 2012 in terms of the General Regulations for University
Postgraduate Awards, 2008
for the Degree of Master of Pharmacy – M.Pharm. -
under the auspices of the Faculty of Medicine and Surgery**

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon him by articles 74 (5) and 75 (6) of the Education Act (Cap. 327), the Chancellor of the University of Malta has promulgated the following bye-laws made by the Board of the Faculty of Medicine and Surgery in virtue of the powers conferred upon it by article 81 (1) of the said Act and which have been approved by the Senate of the University of Malta as required by article 81 (2) of the said Act:

Citation and Interpretation

1. (1) These bye-laws may be cited as the Bye-Laws of 2012 in terms of the General Regulations for University Postgraduate Awards, 2008 for the degree of Master of Pharmacy - M.Pharm. - under the auspices of the Faculty of Medicine and Surgery.

(2) In these bye-laws, unless the context otherwise requires -

“the Board” means the Board of the Faculty of Medicine and Surgery;

“the Course” means the programme of study leading to the degree of Master of Pharmacy – M.Pharm.;

“the Degree” means the degree of Master of Pharmacy – M.Pharm.; and

“the Principal Regulations” means the General Regulations for University Postgraduate Awards, 2008.

Applicability

2. These bye-laws shall be applicable for courses commencing in October 2011 or later.

Requirements for Admission

3. (1) The Course shall be open to applicants in possession of the degree of Bachelor of Science (Honours) (Pharmaceutical Science) obtained with at least Second Class Honours.

(2) Applicants in possession of the degree of Bachelor of Science (Honours) (Pharmaceutical Science) obtained with Third Class Honours shall be eligible to apply if they submit a portfolio covering three years' practice in an area related to pharmacy.

Course Duration

4. The Course shall extend over three semesters of full-time study.

Programme of Study

5. (1) The programme of study shall comprise study-units to which a total of 90 credits are assigned, of which 60 credits are assigned to taught and practical study-units and 30 credits are assigned to the dissertation study-unit.

(2) The programme of study shall be published after approval by Senate, normally not less than eight months prior to the commencement of the Course and shall include:

(a) theoretical and practical training in the following subjects:

Pharmacy Practice
Clinical Pharmacy
Community Health Care
Legislation and Professional Ethics;

(b) at least six months of in-service training in a pharmacy open to the public or in a hospital under the supervision of the pharmaceutical department of that hospital; and

(c) a dissertation study-unit.

Assessment and Progress

6. The assessment of the taught study-units shall be held by the end of the semester in which the teaching of the study-units is held.

Dissertation

7. (1) Students shall be required to submit an individual dissertation of approximately 25,000 words. The title of the dissertation and a detailed research proposal shall be submitted at the time of application.

(2) Each student shall be assigned a supervisor who shall provide guidance and advice on a continuous basis during the period of study.

8. (1) Students shall be required to have regular contact with their supervisor.

(2) Supervisors shall submit to the Board progress reports for each student under their supervision at the end of each semester of study. Such reports may include a recommendation to either (a) extend the period of study in order to enable the student to complete the dissertation; or (b) terminate studies prematurely if the supervisor deems this to be proper in the circumstances, provided that:

(i) the extension of the study period referred to in (a) shall be in accordance with the provisions of the Principal Regulations; and

(ii) the Board may not terminate studies prematurely according to (b) until it has first given the student a chance to be heard.

Classification of the Award

9. The Final Weighted Average Mark for the purpose of the classification of the Degree shall be based on the results obtained in all the components of the programme of study, all credits being weighted equally.
